Call Council Meeting to Order: At 4:39PM Mayor Good called the meeting to order.

Establish Quorum: Mayor Good asked Administrator Jones if there was a quorum and he responded in the affirmative.

New Business:

1. Back Parking Lot

- a. Playground – discussion about the current playground its drawbacks: concerns on condition, location, composition, etc. Spoke about a future playground placement on property. Need to take down old and start fresh. Mayor will call around to find contractor to take old down and remove. Possibility of a fund raiser to buy new equipment.
- b. Parking Lot Improvements – discussion on revamping parking spacings, ADA parking spots, concrete bars needed along back ditch, parking spaces at library. Some items spoke about last year need to pick up again in 2025. Also, Council talked about two lamp posts that are laying out on the property need to be reconnected by Georgia Power.
- c. Beckom House – Discussed tear down. Revisiting getting vendor quotes. Three proposals from the past left the Town doing most of the afterwork. Property needs to be cleaned and leveled. Plant trees along the perimeter on side of neighbors house as requested by homeowner once project is completed.

2. Community Revitalization

- a. Food Trucks – Angie Moore, Community Center Coordinator, was given a task to research information on Food Trucks for events at the Town of Sharpsburg. She presented her findings including costs, deposits, using community center, cleanups, staffing, etc. She contacted fifteen vendors in total and heard back from ten. Their requirements are all different. No decisions made.
- b. Movie Night – Ideas were tossed around for having movie nights and other family events at the Town. Events would have to be unique and purposeful to draw families out to enjoy the outdoor space.

3. **Other Matters of Interest** – Purple container needs to be emptied, and trash tossed. The table set-up at Council Meetings needs to be tightened; they still operate at Covid spacing. Hearing issues in the room. BBQ pit on property - what to do with it.
