MINUTES OF PUBLIC HEARING

November 19, 2007

An open and public hearing, posted pursuant to the open meetings law, was held on Monday, November 19, 2007, at 6:30 pm in the Town of Sharpsburg at the Bridges Recreation Center.

Present were the following: Wendell Staley, Mayor; Derrick McElwaney, Mayor Pro-Tem; Clay Cole, Council Member; Stan Parten, Council Member; Donna Camp, Town Clerk. Council Member Hyde was absent.

The purpose of the Public Hearing was to comment on the proposed Amendments to the Comprehensive Plan and the Capital Improvements Element which is to be submitted to the Chattahoochee-Flint Regional Development Center for review.

The Mayor opened the meeting by welcoming the citizens in attendance and introduced Bobby Sills of Nelsnick Enterprises. Bobby Sills discussed the final draft of the Comprehensive Plan and the Capital Improvements Element Amendments.
