MINUTES OF THE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING**

January 8, 2018

A called meeting of the Sharpsburg Town Council was held Monday, January 8, 2018, at 6:00pm, at the Sharpsburg Recreation Center.

Clerk Donna Camp administered the oaths of office to Elizabeth Good and Cynthia Puckett-Pike.

Present were the following: Wendell Staley, Mayor; Stan Parten, Council Member; Elizabeth Good, Council Member; Cynthia Puckett-Pike, Council Member; Polly Garlington, Council Member; Donna Camp, Town Clerk.

The Pledge of Allegiance was delivered.

The Clerk verified there was a quorum present.

The minutes of the December 18, 2017 Council Meeting were reviewed and approved by unanimous vote and were filed in the minute book of the Town.

- Blue Cole – Wanted to know what would happens now with the insurance lapse for the Clerk?


Polling of the Council –
