MINUTES OF THE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING**

June 4, 2018

A regular meeting of the Sharpsburg Town Council was held Monday, June 4, 2018, at 6:00 p.m., at the Sharpsburg Recreation Center.

Present were the following: Stan Parten, Mayor Pro-Tem, Elizabeth Good, Council Member; Cynthia Puckett-Pike, Council Member; Polly Garlington, Council Member; Brad Sears, Town Attorney.

The Pledge of Allegiance was delivered.

The Town Attorney verified there was a quorum present.

Mayor Pro-Tem Parten called for a motion to accept the resignation of Stan Parten as Mayor Pro-Tem. Council Member Good motioned, Council Member Puckett-Pike seconded. Motion carried by unanimous vote

The Town Attorney asked for nominations for Mayor Pro-Tem. Council Member Parten nominated Council Member Good. Council Member Garlington seconded. Motion carried by unanimous vote.

The minutes of the May 7, 2018 Council meeting and the May 14, 2018 called Council meeting were reviewed and approved by unanimous vote and were filed in the minute book of the Town.

Mayor Pro-Tem Good called for a motion to accept the resignation of Council Member Garlington from her Council Post 3. Council Member Parten motioned, Council Member Puckett-Pike seconded. Motion carried by unanimous vote.

Mayor Pro-Tem Good asked for a motion to adopt the Special Election Resolution for a special election on November 5, 2018, to fill the unexpired term for the Council Member Post 3 seat. Council Member Parten motioned, Council Member Puckett-Pike seconded. Motion carried by unanimous vote.


MAYOR'S MINUTES – N/A
